An overview of the features of the bibliographic model proposed by BDRC


This document describes the bibliographical model proposed and used by BDRC on the new BUDA platform.

Origins


The bibliographic model is a simplification of the <u>FRBR</u> Work, Expression, Manifestation, and Item (WEMI) and <u>BIBFRAME2</u> models. We conflate the WEM elements into the single concept **Work** and retain the idea of **Item** that captures an existing digital (scan images or text input) or physical presence of a Work.


Simple Example (based on the BIBFRAME2 schema):




Simple example of a work with different parts:
